The redevelopment of the Melbourne Docklands offers the opportunity to provide a new vision and focus for the city, while building upon the considerable strengths that the city currently enjoys. As part of the EDAW team, my responsibility was to work with the Docklands Authority to provide urban design guidelines which focused on the integration between the various precinct developments with the public realm. A proforma was designed to set criteria developers were asked to submit as part of the approval process. The criteria looked at a number of issues including the relationships of mixed uses and multiple modes of access, quality of built form and open space, and staging guidelines that aimed to promote economic viability during interim development.
