Detail Plan of Proposed Public Space

Neutral Bay is located in North Sydney with good access to the Central Business District and downtown Sydney. The precinct is bisected by a large arterial road with limited pedestrian crossing points. The Shopping Village is the heart of community and has been in decline, in part, due to disinvestment, lack of shopper parking and low character identity. EDAW was commissioned to undertake an Urban Design Study focused on identifying opportunities including mixed-use redevelopment, including increased fixed-term leased shopper parking and phased streetscape improvements aimed at strengthening economic viability. As project manager and lead urban designer, my responsibilities were to work with the design team including sub-consultants to lead all aspects of the project including analysis, design and report writing as well as administrative tasks including project coordination, financial tracking and client meetings.
