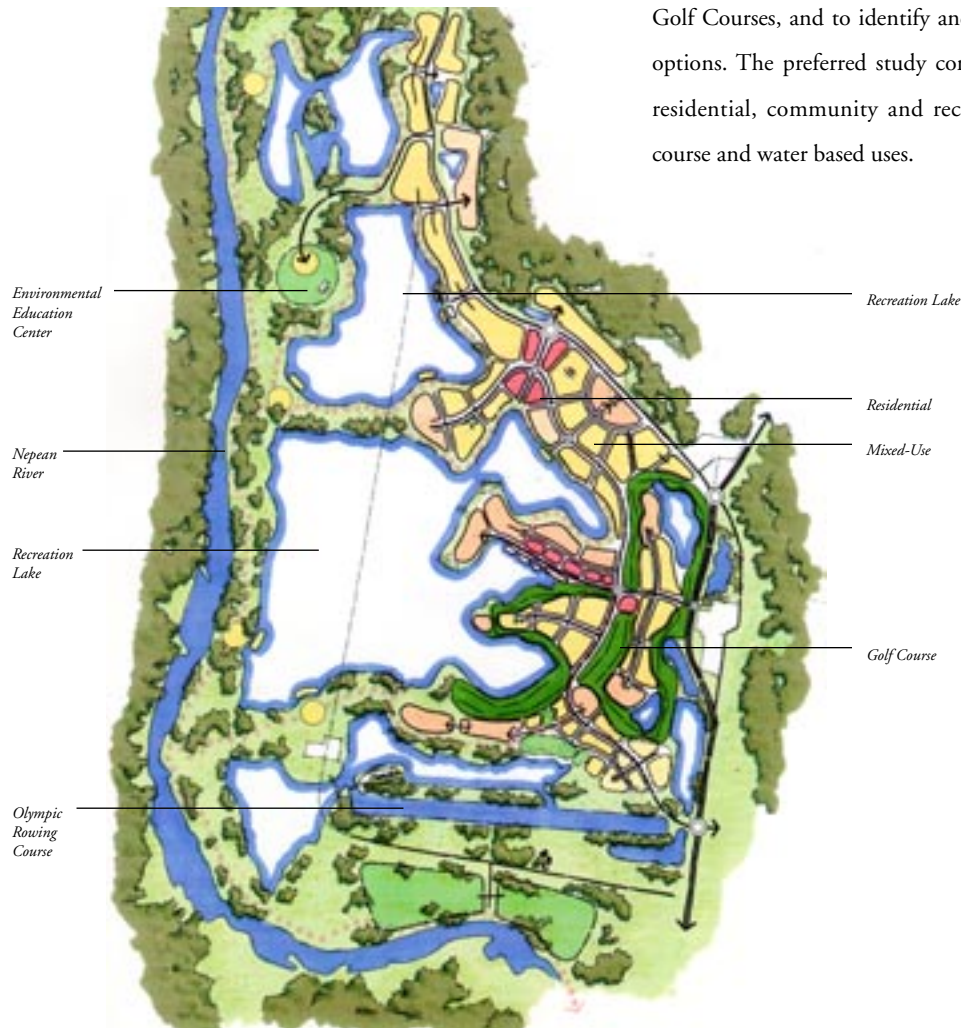

The Penrith Lakes site is located in Western Sydney and is comprised of 1,900 hectares of land within a flood plain. The land has been used for quarrying operations and has supplied approximately half of Sydney's annual sand and gravel requirements, and is now the home of the Olympic Rowing Course for the 2000 games. EDAW was engaged by the Medallist Corporation to aid in their bid to develop the Penrith Lakes site. My responsibilities were to coordinate with our client and his consultants, who included, a South Australian housing developer and Greg Norman Golf Courses, and to identify and evaluate suitable development options. The preferred study contained mixed-use, educational, residential, community and recreational uses including a golf course and water based uses.
